Day 1 Toronto Arrival

Upon arrival in Toronto, you will be met and transferred to your hotel. (24-hour airport free pick-up, airport codes YYZ)

* **Airport pick-up arrangement:** The pick-up service time is within 1 hour after the flight arrives. * **Round trip transfer fee is CAD\$8/person.**

* **Upgrade to Sheraton /Hilton or similar(including breakfast or breakfast bag) (upgrade difference/room/night: USD85/single or double room; USD100/3-person room; USD120/4-person room)**

Day 2 Toronto – Quebec City (B)

In the morning, we will depart from Toronto and pass through Montreal to Quebec City, the capital of Quebec Province, and head to Quebec City, the oldest city in Canada. The only best-preserved ancient city wall in North America, the elegant castle hotel, the graceful old church, the magnificent Quebec Parliament Building, and enjoy a French dinner in a romantic atmosphere.

Day 3 Quebec City – Kings Landing – Hartland Covered Bridge – Fredericton (B)

Leave the hotel in the morning and enter New Brunswick, then arrive at the Kings Landing, the world's longest covered bridge and a National Historic Site of Canada. Experience life in 19th century New Brunswick and taste the hearty soups that villagers cooked over a crackling fire! Arrive in Fredericton, the capital of New Brunswick, at dusk. **If the Kings Landing attraction is closed, it will be replaced by a water Montmorency Falls**

【Hotel】Holiday Inn/Fredericton Inn/Radisson (Including breakfast)

Day 4 Fredericton – Peggy's Cove – Halifax (B)

Continue our journey to Nova Scotia and visit the most famous city – Halifax. Enjoy stunning seaside scenery on the Halifax cruise. Afterward, we will visit Maritime Museum of the Atlantic, and Canadian Museum of Immigration at Pier 21. Later in the afternoon, we will make a stop to Peggy' s Cove, a beautiful fishing village known for its famous Peggy' s Point Lighthouse.

【Hotel】Hampton Inn & Suite or similar (Including breakfast)

Day 5 Halifax - PEI – Charlottetown – Lobster Dinner (B)

Process to the smallest province of Canada – Prince Edward Island. Arrive Charlottetown, the provincial capital and visit the famous novel birthplace – Anne of Green Gables. **Red lobster Dinner there will be a campfire activity (according to weather report or government restriction).**

【Hotel】Cavendish Memo Tree Resort (exclude breakfast)

Day 6 PEI – Big Lobster – Hopewell Rocks – Saint John - Fredericton

After breakfast, drive across the 13 km long Confederation Bridge into New Brunswick. First, we arrived at the symbol of the Maritime Province - the giant lobster statue to take a photo, then went to the Cape Rock Forest in the Bay of Fundy, and then to the magical Magnetic Hill. The car climbs the hill without power. Then drive to visit the bay city of St. John's. Arrive at your hotel in Fredericton at dusk and rest.

Day 7 Fredericton - Montreal (B)

Depart to Montreal in the morning. After arriving in Montreal, visit the famous Montreal Biodome, which reconstructs the five major ecosystems of the Americas, divided into five natural ecological zones: tropical rainforest, polar regions, Canadian deciduous forest, St. Lawrence River, and Labrador Coast. Known as "the most representative and worthwhile attraction" and Old Montreal. 【Hotel】Radison/Quality or similar (Including breakfast)

Day 8 Montreal – Ottawa – 1000 Islands – Toronto (B)

Go to the capital, Ottawa, and visit Parliament Hill (outdoors), where sculpture art reaches its peak, and the National Museum of History, one of the largest museums in the world. Then head to Thousand Island Lake National Park. Group members can take a cruise at their own expense to enjoy the charming scenery of the St. Lawrence River and the luxurious villas on the large and small islands. You can also see the famous shortest international bridge and Love Island, and return to Toronto at dusk.

【Hotel】Quality/Comfort Inn /Best Western or similar(Including breakfast or breakfast bag

Day 9 Toronto - Niagara Falls (B)

Depart early in the morning to the world-famous Niagara Falls. After lunch at your own expense, take the world-famous "Trumpeter" Falls Scenic Boat ("Seasonal Tour), then visit the world-famous Niagara Falls vineyard area and taste Canadian specialty ice wine for free. After dinner, free at leisure. Overnight at Falls Hotel. (Must stay at a hotel in the center of the waterfall area) 【Hotel】Comfort Inn or similar (8-10 minutes' drive to the spot) (no breakfast)

Day 10 Niagara Falls - Downtown Toronto Tour - Toronto International Airport YYZ

Depart early in the morning to the CN Tower (exterior), and then visit Ripley's Aquarium of Canada, the largest aquarium in North America located in Toronto. Then we will go to Lake Ontario to take a sightseeing boat (seasonal trip). After lunch, drive to visit the University of Toronto, Chinatown, and the Toronto Provincial Parliament in downtown Toronto. Then head to the brand new attraction, "Adventure in Little Canada." Finally, visit Casa Loma (exterior) and arrive at Toronto YYZ Airport in the evening. **Please book domestic flights after 8PM/international flights after 9PM. *The above itinerary sequence is for reference only.**
