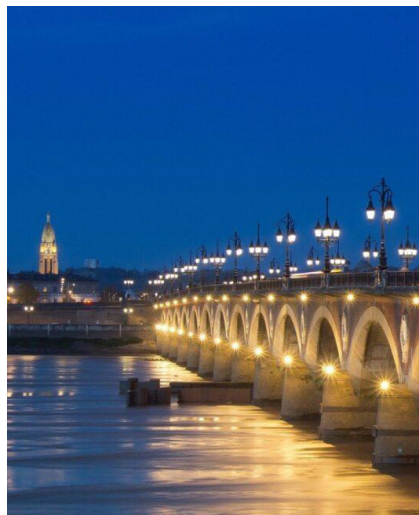

DAY 1 Departure - Paris - Chambord - Limoges

Arrive at Paris CDG Airport before 9AM, PICK-UP and then ogo to **Château de Chambord** (inside visit) · One of the most famous chateaux in the Loire Valley region of France and a representative of French Renaissance architecture. The design of Château de Chambord is often associated with the Italian Renaissance master Leonardo da Vinci, and although there is no conclusive evidence that da Vinci was directly involved in the design. The structure of the chateau blends the traditional French medieval fortress style with the aesthetics of the Italian Renaissance.

DAY 2 Limoges - Bordeaux

Visit the winery, **Bordeaux** is not only a paradise for wine lovers, but also a great opportunity to experience the traditional French winemaking culture and cuisine. Taste the unique Bordeaux wines, where the culture and history of wine can bring you a profound experience.

DAY 3 Bordeaux - Arcachon - Bordeaux

Miroir d'Eau, The largest reflecting pool in the world, located in front of the Place de la Bourse on the banks of the Garonne. Great for daytime photos or nighttime light reflections.

Cathédrale Saint-André, Bordeaux's most famous Gothic building, with its magnificent carvings and historic atmosphere, next to the Tour Pey-Berland overlooking the city.

Dune du Pilat, The highest sand dune in Europe, it is one of the most famous natural attractions in France, attracting a large number of tourists with its spectacular dune landscapes, stunning seaside scenery and unique ecological environment.

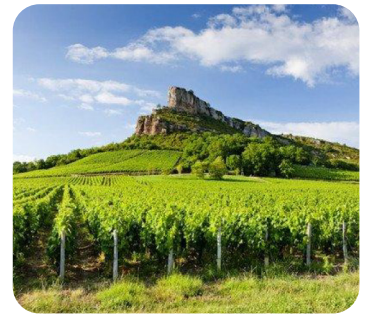
