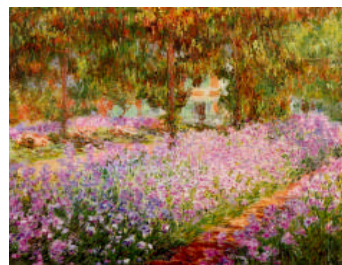
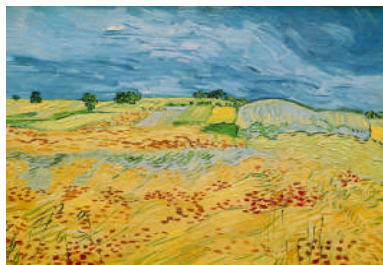

DAY 1 Departure - Paris

Land in Paris CDG Airport by 9:00 a.m. Pick up and start the tour.

Notre-Dame Cathedral (exterior visit) : This Gothic church is a Parisian landmark with a long history and architectural value :

Louvre (INSIDE VISIT) : One of the largest art museums in the world, with a large collection of art treasures, including the Mona Lisa.

Basilique du Sacré-Cœur, Situated at the highest point in Paris and one of the landmarks of Montmartre, the white facade of the church contrasts with the blue sky.

Le Mur des Je T'aime : With "I love you" written on the wall in 250 languages, this is a romantic spot for lovers.

DAY 3 Paris - Étretat - Normandy U.S. Military Cemetery

After finishing breakfast in the hotel, today's tour starts at 8:30am.

L'Arche d'Étretat, a small town in the Normandy region of France, is a masterpiece of nature's handiwork, famous for its spectacular chalk cliffs and unique elephant trunk shape.

Normandy American Cemetery and Memorial, An important site for honoring American soldiers who died in the Battle of Normandy, located in Colleville-sur-Mer, Normandy, France, overlooking Omaha Beach. This cemetery is one of the most important memorial sites of the Normandy landings, symbolizing the defense of freedom and the desire for peace.

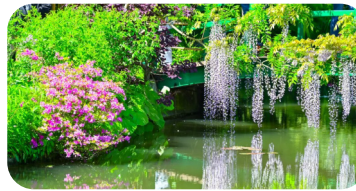
DAY 4 St Malo

Saint-Malo, Located on the northern coast of the Bretagne region of France, this historic port city is known for its ancient walls, stunning beaches and unique pirate culture. Once an important trading port and pirate stronghold in the history of France, it is now a well-known tourist city, known as the "Pearl of the Emerald Coast".

DAY 5 St Malo - Mont St. Michel - Giverny

After finishing breakfast in the hotel, today's tour starts at 8:30am.

Mont-Saint-Michel, Located in Normandy, France, the Mont Saint-Michel is a small island in the tidal plains of the Atlantic Ocean. Known as the "Miracle of the West", was inscribed as a World Heritage Site in 1997. Mont Saint-Michel is famous for its tidal changes, when the sea is high tide, the island is completely surrounded by sea water, like a "fortress on the sea"; when the tide is low tide, it reveals a large area of mud flats, connected to the mainland.

DAY 6 Monet's Garden - Auvers Van Gogh Town - Paris

After finishing breakfast in the hotel, today's tour starts at 8:30am.

Monet's Garden (INSIDE VISIT) : The private garden of Monet, the master of Impressionism. The garden was designed by Monet himself, and he created his famous "Water Lilies" series of large-scale oil paintings, "Japanese Bridge" and other famous works here.

Auvers-sur-Oise, It is the place where Van Gogh spent the last 70 days of his life. Walking on the same path that Van Gogh walked, seeing the same scenery that Van Gogh painted, and looking forward to an unexpected encounter in this town that is like an open-air museum.
