Day 1

Corning - Niagara Falls US

Day 2

Niagara Falls Canada - Toronto

After that, head to Skylon Tower to view the falls, and enjoy a delicious meal in the 360-degree revolving restaurant or the top buffet restaurant. After lunch, head to Toronto, the largest city in Canada. Toronto is a bustling, vibrant international metropolis.
