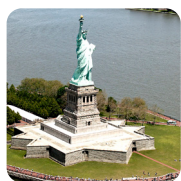

Day3 Philadelphia - Washington D.C.

Itinerary: Philadelphia double deck bus(optional 60 Min) → National Independence Historical Park→ Capitol Building U.S. Capitol In-depth Tour (Optional, inside visit U.S. Capitol outside visit Supreme Court of the United States & Library of Congress, 120 mins) → National Mall → White House → Lincoln Memorial, Korean War Memorial, Vietnam Veterans Memorial, Jefferson Memorial (passing) → WW II Memorial (passing)Hotel : Springhill Suites by Marriott Gaithersburg , Doubletree by Hilton Sterling or similar
