### DAY 2 Philadelphia - Washington D.C.

HOTEL : Springhill Suites by Marriott Gaithersburg , Doubletree by Hilton Sterling or similar

Philadelphia double deck bus(optional 60 Min) → National Independence Historical Park → Capitol Building U.S. Capitol In-depth Tour (Optional, inside visit U.S. Capitol outside visit Supreme Court of the United States & Library of Congress, 120 mins) → National Mall → White House → Lincoln Memorial, Korean War Memorial, Vietnam Veterans Memorial, Jefferson Memorial (passing) → WW II Memorial (passing)

### DAY 3 Corning - Niagara Falls (US SIDE)

HOTEL : Marriott Amherst or similar

Cross the Border into Canada in the morning, then we will ride on the Hornblow in the morning heading to Corning to visit the Corning Museum of Glass: a museum dedicated to the art, history, and science of glass. Collection of more than 50,000 glasses objects, some over 3,500 years old and enjoys live hot glass show. Then head back to hotel. Customers can join the optional night tour of the Niagara Falls.

### DAY 4 Niagara Falls Canada - Toronto

HOTEL : Avid hotel Toronto - Vaughan Southwest or similar

Cross the Border into Canada in the morning, then we will ride on the Hornblower Cruise with up-close viewing of the Falls. After that, head to Skylon Tower to view the falls, and enjoy a delicious meal in the 360-degree revolving restaurant or the top buffet restaurant. ### DAY 5 Thousand Islands - Ottawa – Montreal

Depart from Toronto in the morning to Thousand Islands, are a group of more than 1,800 islands in the St. Lawrence River, straddling the border of the U.S. and Canada. Then Ottawa, the capital of Canada: The Parliament Building, the Peace Tower, and the "Centennial Fire". Then head north to Montreal, the largest French-speaking city in Canada, and known as the "Little Paris of North America".

### DAY 6 Montreal - Quebec City - Boston (Hotel at Nashua, NH)

Itinerary: Quebec Old Town walking tour (Optional) : Including Old Town Petit Champlain Street, the Royale Place, the Château Frontenac, the Parliament Building, the appearance of the Notre-Dame Basilica of Quebec → French meal (Optional), then return to the United States, overnight at the Nashua, NH.
