DAY 1 Arrival at Mexico City (MEX)

HOTEL : 4 star : Hotel Royal Reforma or similar
5 star : heraton Mexico City Maria Isabel Hotel or similar

24 hours Mexico city Airport pick-up (no tour guide ,driver only) and transfer to hotel for rest .

DAY 2 Mexico City - Teotihuacan (B/L)

Arrive at the Plaza de la Cultura, a fusion of ancient Indian culture, Spanish colonial culture and modern Mexican culture, with buildings from different periods, and the former location of the Mexican Ministry of Foreign Affairs. Go to Teotihuacan. Visit the Teotihuacan Sun and Moon Pyramids. Teotihuacan is the largest religious city-state in Mexico. Climbing the majestic pyramids, you will feel the prosperity and splendor of this ancient city-state that was once as prosperous as Rome at that time. Enjoy a rich Mexican traditional buffet lunch, and watch the live performances of the Mexican band and Indian dancers. If you are lucky, you can also hear the Mexican band humming Chinese songs. Visit the Cathedral of Our Lady of Guadalupe, which is a wonder of the Catholic world and one of the three miracle churches recognized by the Pope of Rome. Visit the Soumaya Museum. The museum was invested and built by Mexico's richest man, Carlos Slim, in memory of his late wife.

DAY 3 Mexico City Tour +Xochimilco +Museo Nacional de Antropología+UNAM (LUNCH AT XOCHIMILCO WITH MINI BAND MARIACHI) (B/L)

Visit the Plaza de la Constitución, a must-see attraction in downtown Mexico City, and experience the fusion of ancient civilization and modern atmosphere in Mexico City. Visit the National Palace (exterior). Visit the Metropolitan Cathedral on the other side of the square (inside visit). It is the largest church in the Americas and took 250 years to build. Visit the Aztec Great Temple (exterior). It was once the most important place of worship and celebration in the great city of Tenochtitlan. Visit the largest art palace in Mexico, the Palace of Fine Arts (exterior), and the magnificent Postal Palace (exterior) next to it. Go to the Xochimilco Flower Boat Cruise for lunch on board. This floating town, known as the "Venice of Mexico", was once part of Tenochtitlan, the capital of the Aztecs, the rulers of Mexico. Visit and tour the National Autonomous University of Mexico, the oldest and largest comprehensive university in Mexico and Latin America, and one of the largest institutions of higher learning in the world. Visit and tour the Mexican Museum of Anthropology, one of the largest and most famous museums in Latin America.

DAY 5 Chich'en Itza&Saamal Cenote & Suytun Cenote (B/L/D)

Arrive at the ruins of the ancient city of Chichen Itza, a large pre-Columbian archaeological site built by the Mayan civilization. Go to the Mayan Jungle Manor to enjoy a rich buffet lunch in a local Mexican manor with a history of hundreds of years (free lunch worth \$15, dining time is about 45 minutes). This Mayan manor with a history of nearly two hundred years was once the private residence of a wealthy man. He was attracted by the natural beauty and cenotes here and built his home here. The environment here is beautiful, and the Spanish-style colonial architecture is preserved almost the same as a hundred years ago. The buffet lunch here is also the most famous. Walk to [Manor Samel Cenote], one of the largest cenotes in the Yucatan region. It provides the most considerate services and facilities to all guests, such as shower rooms and changing rooms, lockers and life jackets. Check in at the popular tourist attraction [Suitun Cenote]. A thin bluestone road extends into a turquoise pool. This is the popular cenote "Suitun" that has been liked thousands of times on "Little Red Book" and Instagram!

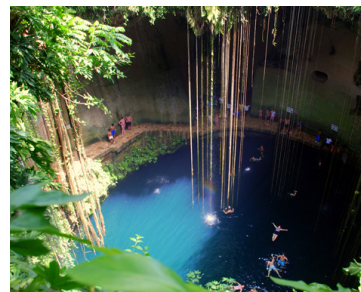
