## Day 1 Toronto Arrival

**HOTEL :** Quality/ Comfort Inn /Best Western or similar

Upon arrival in Toronto, you will be met and transferred to your hotel. (24-hour airport free pick-up, airport codes YYZ)

\* If an order has 2 or more different flights arriving, the latest arrival time will be used as the reference time for pick-up service

\* YTZ Airport, or Toronto Downtown and surrounding areas will charge an additional USD100 per trip as a subsidy fee.

\* Maximum waiting time for airport pick-up service: no more than 90 minutes after the departure of an international flight, or no more than 60 minutes after the departure of a domestic flight respectively. If the waiting time is exceeded and the passenger departs and needs to arrive at the airport, it will be charged again.

## Day 2 Toronto - Thousand Islands - Montreal - "AURA light show" (B)

**HOTEL :** NCEN07A Radisson/Four point by Sheraton or similar (no breakfast) - Register 2 weeks in advance for free upgrade to Group L hotel (no breakfast) NCEN07L Hyatt Place Downtown (no breakfast)

In the early morning, we set off from Toronto and headed to Thousand Islands. We passed through Kingston, the ancient capital of Canada, and car tour the old Parliament Building, which is now City Hall, the 18th-century British lighthouse, the oldest east-west traversing locomotive, and passed the magnificent and luxurious prison, the first The former residence of the Prime Minister, the top-ranked Queen's University, etc. Take the "Thousand Island Lake Sightseeing Boat" (about 1 hour) to the Old Port, a popular tourist attraction in Montreal. You can board the "Ferris Wheel" to enjoy the beautiful scenery of Montreal. Exclusively visit the ancient and magnificent Notre Dame Cathedral.

## Day 3 Montreal - Maple syrup farm - Quebec City

**HOTEL :** NCEN07-A: Lake view Ascend hotel (no breakfast) Upgrade to lake view room surcharge USD100/room (no breakfast) NCEN07-L: 2 weeks in advance and get a free upgrade to a lake view room (no breakfast) Within 2 weeks Upgrade to lake view room surcharge USD100/room (no breakfast)

After breakfast, proceed to Maple Sugar Manor in Sanhe Ancient Town. Enjoy a traditional lunch in the manor (if the Maple Sugar Manor is closed, lunch will be eaten elsewhere) in a harmonious and warm atmosphere. You can taste lollipops made with fresh maple sugar for free. Then go to the oldest city in Canada and the only North American city with city walls. First, climb to the observation deck on the 31st floor of the tallest building in the city, the Mary Building, to view the scenery of Quebec City, and then enter the ancient city of Quebec. The architecture of the ancient city exudes a unique French style and is also an excellent representative of a colonial fortress city. In the evening, you can also enjoy French dinner. Check into the hotel and rest after the meal.

## Day 4 Quebec City - Montmorency Falls- Mont-Tremblant

**HOTEL :** Free Upgrade to Fairmont (no breakfast)

After bidding farewell to the ancient city of Quebec, now will take you to see the unique Montmorency Falls (commonly known as "Crystal Falls"). Because it has a drop of 83 meters, which is 1.5 times that of Niagara Falls, it is quite majestic. Take the cable car to the top of the waterfall to enjoy the beautiful scenery on both sides of the St. Lawrence River. After lunch, go to Mont-Tremblant Resort. Take the cable car at the foot of the mountain to reach the highest peak in Katong (3300 feet) "Fairy Camel Peak".

## Day 5 Mont-Tremblant - Ottawa - Kingston - Toronto

**HOTEL :** Quality/ Comfort Inn /Best Western or similar

In the morning, we left Mont-Tremblant and headed to Ottawa, the capital of Canada, to visit the pinnacle of sculpture art - Parliament Hill (outside view). Then we went to visit the "National Museum of History" and along the newly designed "Time Tunnel" to appreciate Canada's 10,000-year-old Years of human development history and the formation process of multi-ethnic culture. Also visit the "Canadian War Museum", one of the three most important war art collection venues in the world. After lunch, return to Toronto.

## Day 6 Toronto - Niagara Falls (B)

**HOTEL :** Comfort Inn or similar (8-10 minutes' drive to the spot)

Departing early morning to the world-famous Niagara Falls. Upon arrival, begin your Falls experience with an IMAX movie - Niagara: Miracles, Myths & Magic, to learn about the shocking and exiting history of Niagara Falls. You will then go up the Skylon Tower for a panoramic view of the magnificent Horseshoe Falls, the American Falls and the Bridal Veil Falls. After lunch at your own expense, ride on the famous Horn blower cruise (\*seasonal) for a close-up view of the magnificent Falls. Then visit the Niagara wine region for a taste test of our world-famous ice wine. Free activities after dinner. Enjoy a unique night view of the waterfall illuminated by colorful lights, as well as the gorgeous fireworks. Or head to the busiest Clifton Hill and ride the Ferris Wheel to get the best night view of the waterfall in the coolest and most spectacular way.

## Day 7 Niagara Falls - Downtown Toronto Tour

Depart early in the morning and arrive in Toronto, first arriving at the iconic CN Tower in Canada (photo stop). Next, visit the largest aquarium in North America, Ripley's Aquarium of Canada, covering 135,000 square feet and featuring thousands of aquatic animals. Then, take a sightseeing boat ride on Lake Ontario (seasonal activity). After lunch at your own expense, enjoy a drive past the University of Toronto, Chinatown, and the Ontario Legislative Building in downtown Toronto. Then head to the new attraction "Little Canada", where you can closely explore miniature representations of Canada's most iconic buildings, landmarks, and culture. This project has taken nearly 10 years to develop and will continue to expand over the next five years. Finally, visit Casa Loma (photo stop), a medieval castle perched on a hill that exudes both nobility and ancient mystery. Its unique architectural style has attracted numerous Hollywood films for location shooting. Arrive at Toronto YYZ Airport at dusk. Please arrange Domestic flights: After 8PM; Internation flights: After 9PM.
