## Day1 Toronto Arrival

**HOTEL :** Quality/Comfort Inn/ Best Western or similar  
Upgrade to Sheraton Parkway (breakfast or breakfast bag included)  
(additional surcharge:/room/night: USD85/single-double room;  
USD100/triple room; USD120/quad room)

Upon arrival in Toronto, you will be met and transferred to your hotel. (24-hour airport free pick-up, airport codes YYZ) \* If an order has 2 or more different flights arriving, the latest arrival time will be used as the reference time for pick-up service  
\* YZT Airport, or Toronto Downtown and surrounding areas will charge USD100 per trip as a subsidy fee.\*Maximum waiting time for airport pick-up service: no more than 90 minutes after the departure of an international flight, or no more than 60 minutes after the departure of a domestic flight respectively. If the waiting time is exceeded and the passenger departs and needs to arrive at the airport, it will be charged again.Pick up & drop off service fee per person/CAD8

## Day2 Toronto - Kingston - Ottawa - Montreal (B)

**HOTEL :** Comfort/Quality Hotel or similar

You will start your tour to Canada's Capital city, Ottawa. On the way, you will pass through Kingston, where you can see the old Parliament building (drive through), which now serves as the City Hall, and the famous Queen's University (drive through). Then, you will continue the journey to Canada's capital, Ottawa, to admire the Parliament Hill (photo stop). After that, you will visit the Canadian War Museum, the largest museum in Canada dedicated to war artifacts and materials. Next, you will explore the largest museum in Canada, the Canadian Museum of History. As evening approaches, you will head to the historic and beautiful neighborhood of Old Montreal, where you can see Notre-Dame Basilica (photo stop) and Chinatown.

## Day3 Montreal -Ice Hotel - Quebec City (B)

**HOTEL :** Book two weeks in advance GSCEC05 Hotel: Free Upgrade to GSCEC05-D hotel: Hôtel Royal William / Hotel Le Concorde or similar (Exclude breakfast) Book two weeks in advance GSCEC05-D:add USD1/pp Upgrade to GSCEC05-V: Fairmont Le Chateau Frontenac ( Exclude breakfast) (V Group requires further confirmed)

After breakfast, climb to Mount Royal, overlooking Montreal, and visit the largest Catholic Church of St. Joseph in North America. Then go to visit the Olympic Park, the site of the 1976 Olympic Games, which was later converted into the only natural ecological museum in North America. Follow up with a visit to the Montreal Insectarium Plants from around the world grow indoors, and light-filled gardens allow visitors to get up close and personal with butterflies. Then taste the local special farmhouse dishes at your own expense and experience the Canadian style "farmhouse". After lunch, visit the winter artificial wonder \* Ice Hotel Quebec (Opening date: January to March 2026,subject to updates). Then enter Quebec City, the oldest city in Canada. For dinner, enjoy a special meal in a French restaurant, which will allow you to fully enjoy the romantic feelings of the European continent. rest in the hotel after dinner.

\*Ice Hotel Opening Dates: January , 2026, to March, (During closure or when not open, the attraction is adjusted to "Observatoire de la Capital"  
\*In December, we arranges exclusive attractions (replacing the observation deck attractions)

## Day4 Quebec City - Toronto (B)

**HOTEL :** Quality/Comfort Inn/ Best Western or similar  
Upgrade to Sheraton Parkway (breakfast or breakfast bag included)  
(additional surcharge: USD85/single/double; USD100/triple; USD120/quad)

After breakfast, under the guidance of a guide, you will experience another winter snow project at your own expense~ Take a husky dog sled to go hunting in the big forest. (The dog sled is a seasonal itinerary and will be modified or cancelled due to weather and other reasons. Working animals in dog sleds are kept under strict government animal protection regulations). After lunch on the way, pass through Thousand Islands, take a helicopter at your own expense (according to the weather conditions of the day or not), and return to Toronto at about dusk.

## Day5 Toronto - Niagara Falls - Toronto YYZ Airport (B)

Depart early in the morning for the world-famous Niagara Falls. Due to the cold weather, there are strips of silver-covered icicles on the waterfall. First, enjoy the IMAX waterfall movie to learn about the magical, mysterious and mythical Niagara Falls. Then climb to the skyron tower to watch the icefall in 360 degrees. After lunch at your own expense, visit the Bird Kingdom. This is the world's largest free-flying indoor bird viewing garden. Afterwards, we will visit the world-famous Niagara Falls vineyard area and taste Canadian specialty ice wine for free. Please arrange Domestic flights: After 8PM; Internation flights: After 9PM.
