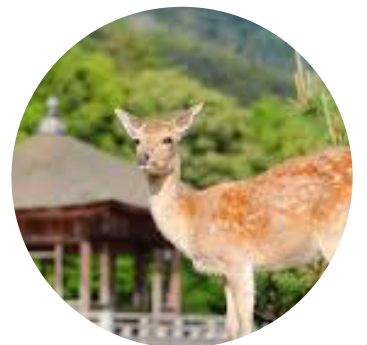

## DAY 07

### Imperial Kyoto, Playful Deer & Osaka's Kitchen

Next, walk the mesmerizing path of thousands of vermilion torii gates at Fushimi Inari Taisha—a photographer's dream. Travel to Nara Park, where hundreds of friendly, bowing wild deer wait to greet you; don't miss the spiritual atmosphere of Kasuga Taisha Shrine nearby. As evening falls, we head to Osaka to visit the majestic Osaka Castle Park. Finally, dive into the sensory explosion of Dotonbori and Shinsaibashi. The air is thick with the smell of takoyaki and okonomiyaki under the neon glow of the Glico Man. Dinner is a culinary adventure of your own choosing.
