DAY 1 ISTANBUL

Arrival at Istanbul Airport and meeting with the assistant (at Gate 9). Transfer to the hotel and accommodation.

HOTEL : NIPPON HOTEL TAKSIM or RAMADA BY WYNDHAM ISTANBUL TAKSIM HOTEL OR SIMILAR

DAY 2 ISTANBUL (B/L)

Breakfast at the hotel and start of the visit to the Suleiman the Magnificent Mosque. Then continue to the Egyptian Bazaar (Spice Bazaar), the second largest and oldest bazaar in Istanbul, where you can shop for spices, dried fruits, sweets, saffron, tea, and caviar. Afterwards, enjoy a Bosphorus Cruise on a regular ferry sailing between Europe and Asia. Along the way, admire the natural beauty of the region, Ottoman palaces, waterfront mansions featured in Turkish TV series, Ortaköy Square and cafés, the Mecidiye Mosque, and the suspension bridges connecting the two continents.

Lunch at a local restaurant. Return to the hotel and accommodation.

HOTEL : NIPPON HOTEL TAKSIM or RAMADA BY WYNDHAM ISTANBUL TAKSIM HOTEL OR SIMILAR

DAY 3 ISTANBUL – ANKARA – SALT LAKE – CAPPADOCIA (B/L/D)

Breakfast (Lunch Box) and early departure to Ankara, the capital of the modern Turkish Republic. Panoramic city tour with a stop at Atatürk Mausoleum.

Continue to Cappadocia with a stop at the Salt Lake along the way.

Arrival in Cappadocia and transfer to the hotel. Dinner and accommodation.

HOTEL : PERISSIA HOTEL or EMIN KOÇAK HOTEL OR SIMILAR

DAY 4 CAPPADOCIA (B/L/D)

OPTIONAL TOUR: HOT AIR BALLOON RIDE

Enjoy a breathtaking panorama over one of the most beautiful regions in the world. Breakfast at the hotel. Departure to visit an underground city built by Christian communities seeking protection from Roman persecution.

Continue with visits to Göreme Valley and Devrent Valley. Lunch at a local restaurant. Visit a traditional carpet workshop famous for handmade carpets produced using ancient techniques. Dinner at the hotel and accommodation.

OPTIONAL TOUR:

Folk dance show in a traditional cave with limited local drinks included.

HOTEL : PERISSIA HOTEL or EMIN KOÇAK HOTEL OR SIMILAR

DAY 5 CAPPADOCIA (B/L/D)

Breakfast at the hotel and panoramic visits to Avcılar and Güvercinlik Valleys, where you can admire the famous Fairy Chimneys that make Cappadocia so unique.

Lunch at a local restaurant. Visit the ancient village of Uçhisar, located at the highest point of Cappadocia.

OPTIONAL: 4x4 Jeep Safari excursion.

In the afternoon, visit a jewelry and gemstone workshop specialized in typical Cappadocian stones. Dinner at the hotel and accommodation.

HOTEL : PERISSIA HOTEL or EMIN KOÇAK HOTEL OR SIMILAR

DAY 6 CAPPADOCIA – KARAVANSARAI – PAMUKKALE (B/L/D)

Breakfast at the hotel and departure to Pamukkale.

On the way, visit the Sultanhan Caravanserai, an important stop for caravans traveling along the Silk Road. Later, stop at a clothing outlet store.

HOTEL : RICHMOND THERMAL HOTEL or KAYA THERMAL HOTEL OR SIMILAR

DAY 7 AMUKKALE – EPHEBUS – IZMIR (B/L/D)

Breakfast at the hotel and departure to visit the ancient city of Hierapolis ("Cotton Castle"), a true natural wonder famous for its white limestone terraces and thermal pools. Continue to the ruins of Ephesus, the best-preserved Greco-Roman city in Turkey and former capital of the Roman Empire in Asia Minor.

Admire the magnificent Library of Celsus, Marble Street, and the Great Theatre with capacity for 25,000 people, where Saint Paul once preached to his followers.

Visit the House of the Virgin Mary, a Christian pilgrimage site located near Ephesus, where according to tradition Saint John brought the Virgin Mary after the crucifixion of Christ. There will also be time to visit an excellent leather outlet famous for high-quality products from the region.

HOTEL : HAMPTONBY HILTON ALIAGA or RADISSON BLU IZMIR ALIAGA OR SIMILAR

DAY 8 IZMIR – BURSA – ISTANBUL (B/L)

Breakfast at the hotel and departure to Bursa.

Stop to visit a Turkish Delight shop featuring the famous traditional sweets.

Panoramic city tour of Bursa, the first capital of the Ottoman Empire before Edirne. Visit the Green Mosque and the Green Mausoleum, built under the order of Sultan Mehmet I. The mosque is decorated with green and turquoise Iznik tiles, while the mausoleum houses the tombs of Mehmet I and his dynasty.

Lunch at a local restaurant. In Bursa, there will also be time to stroll through the silk market, where you can find antiques, silks, perfumes, and pashminas.

HOTEL : NIPPON HOTEL TAKSIM or RAMADA BY WYNDHAM ISTANBUL TAKSIM HOTEL OR SIMILAR

DAY 9 ISTANBUL (B/L)

Breakfast and departure for the Sultanahmet tour.

Visit Topkapi Palace, residence of the Ottoman Sultans, famous for its beautiful halls and gardens, including the 86-carat Spoonmaker's Diamond, one of the largest in the world. Continue to Hagia Sophia, which had the largest dome in the Christian world for 900 years. Originally a church, later a museum, and today a mosque. Visit the Roman Hippodrome, built during the reign of Emperor Septimius Severus in 203 AD and once considered the center of the city.

Continue to the Blue Mosque, famous for its stunning Iznik tiles. Sultan Ahmet ordered its construction as a replica of Hagia Sophia.

Lunch at a local restaurant. Finish the tour at the Grand Bazaar for shopping.

HOTEL : NIPPON HOTEL TAKSIM or RAMADA BY WYNDHAM ISTANBUL TAKSIM HOTEL OR SIMILAR

DAY 10 ISTANBUL (B)

Breakfast at the hotel (depending on the departure time, a breakfast box may be provided) and transfer to the airport for the return flight.
