DAY 1 ARRIVAL AT ISTANBUL

Upon arrival at Istanbul Airport, the group will meet the guide at Gate 9, located outside the terminal. Transfer to the hotel, allowing travelers to settle in comfortably and rest after the long journey.

DAY 2 ISTANBUL – BOSPHORUS CRUISE (B)

Breakfast at the hotel and start of the visit to the Suleiman the Magnificent Mosque. Then continue to the Egyptian Bazaar (Spice Bazaar), the 2nd largest and oldest bazaar in Istanbul, where guests can shop for spices, dried fruits, sweets, saffron, tea, and caviar.

Afterwards, optionally, we will take a Bosphorus cruise with lunch included (USD 65 per person). The cruise is operated on a regular ferry sailing along the Bosphorus, which separates Asia from Europe. We will have opportunities to photograph the natural beauty of the region, Ottoman palaces, and the famous mansions from Turkish TV series located along the Bosphorus shores. We will also see Ortaköy Square and its cafés, the Mecidiye Mosque, and the suspension bridges connecting the two continents. Return to the hotel and accommodation.

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DAY 3 ISTANBUL CITY TOUR (B/L)

Breakfast at the hotel. Free day. Optionally, guests may join the city tour (USD 180 per person)

Departure for the Sultanahmet tour, visiting Topkapı Palace, residence of the Ottoman Sultans. Visitors can admire the beauty of its halls and gardens, including the 86-carat Spoonmaker's Diamond, one of the largest diamonds in the world. Afterwards, exterior visit of Hagia Sophia, which had the largest dome in the Christian world for 900 years. It was first a church, later a museum, and today a mosque. Lunch included.

Visit to the Roman Hippodrome, dating back to the reign of Roman Emperor Septimius Severus in 203 AD, which represented the center of the city until the establishment of the Republic. Visit to the Blue Mosque, the most visited mosque in the city, famous for its impressive collection of Iznik tiles. Sultan Ahmet ordered it to be built as a replica of Hagia Sophia. Along the way, visit to a clothing outlet store. Tour ends at the Grand Bazaar for shopping.

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DAY 4 ISTANBUL DEPARTURE (B)

Breakfast at the hotel (depending on the flight schedule, a breakfast box may be provided) and transfer to the airport at the scheduled time for the return flight. Arrival at the airport and end of our services.
