DAY 1 WELCOME TO HANOI!

Upon arrival in Hanoi, welcome and transfer (without guide) to hotel in Hanoi center. Check in & Overnight in Hanoi.

HOTEL : BABYLON PREMIUM HOTEL & SPA HANOI (4 Star) or similar

DAY 2 NINH BINH ANCIENT CAPITAL - TRANG AN - HANG MUA CAVES (B/L)

07h30 - 8h00: Our tour guide and driver will pick you up from the hotel in Hanoi Old Quarter for transfer to Ninh Binh. 09h15: Stops on the way for a 15 - 20 minutes short break for you to stretch your legs, use the facilities, or have a quick snack.

10h30: The limousine arrives in Hoa Lu, the ancient capital of Vietnam from years 968 to 1010. Then you will visit the Temple of Dinh King and Le King and learn more about Vietnamese history under the Dinh, Le, and Ly Dynasties. 11h15 - 11h45: It's time to join our 30 minutes cycling activity to discover the life of the local people. Or stay behind and either relax in the restaurant for sightseeing and capture the views around lake, waterfall and valleys.

12h00: It is time for a buffet lunch to enjoy local specialties in the private area of our Trang An Heritage Garden. The vegetarian option is also available.

13h15 - 13h30: Visit Trang An, a World Heritage Site recognized by UNESCO in 2014. There, you can spend 1.5 hours on the boat ride to enjoy the beauty of this place, which owns a beautiful tunnel cave system and appears in the New Version of Kong in 2016 - "Skull Island". 16h00 - 16h30: Transfer back to Hanoi.

18h30 - 19h00: Drop you off at your hotel in Hanoi Old Quarter

DAY 3 HANOI - HALONG BAY FULL DAY (B/L)

07:00 Pick you at one designated meeting points nearby in Old Quarter.

10h30: Have a short break for 20 minutes to relax.

12h00 - 12h30: Arrive Tuan Chau Harbor. Welcome to the Cruise. We will take you on 6 hour journey via 2 day-sleeper boat cruise route which renowned for its striking, passages uninhabited islets and outcrops have been given imaginative names by the locals, due to their perceived shapes while having Buffet lunch on boat. 14h00: You will visit Surprising Cave to see a lot of stalagmites and stalactites with different shapes of sea lives 15h00: Visit Titop Island with sandy beach to the towering limestone mountain with excellent backdrop of the Bay, and climb up Titop Peak for a panoramic view of the bay like paradise.

17h00 - 17h30: Cruising back to Tuan Chau harbor. There are a lot of time for enjoying sunset party, sunbathing on upper deck with music and enjoying great fun of group touring fellows among world iconic natural scenery. 18h00 - 18h30: We get on bus to back Hanoi by Expressway, have a short break for 20-30 minutes. 21h00 - 21h30: Arrive at the hotel in Ha Noi Old Quarter. Trip ends! Attention: The itinerary can be changed due to the check-in time and the weather conditions cruises option on spot.

DAY 4 HANOI CITY TOUR - FLY TO DANANG (B/L)

8.30 pick up at your hotel, start the tour on to beautiful Tran Quoc Pagoda located on the shores of West Lake and visit to Ho Chi Minh complex, including Ho Chi Minh's Mausoleum - the final resting place of Vietnamese great father or Uncle Ho, President Ho Chi Minh's stilt house - where he lived on and off from 1958 to 1969. The next place to move to is One Pillar Pagoda - a group of structures consisting of a pagoda and a tower built in the middle of a square lake. Leave the Pagoda for the Temple of Literature - the first college of Vietnam and the place dedicating to Confucian. Then we pass by the well-known Hanoi train street for photo stop if you wish. Lunch served at a local restaurant for a taste of authentic Hanoi cuisine.

After lunch, free to explore Hanoi Old Quarter then head to the airport for your flight to Da Nang (Flight: to be advised - at your own arrangement)

Upon arrival in Danang, pick up an transfer to hotel for check in.

HOTEL : BLUESUN DANANG BEACH HOTEL (4 Star) or similar

DAY 5 LINH UNG PAGODA - MARBLE MOUNTAIN - COCONUT FOREST - HOI AN (B/D)

Free at leisure in the morning to discover Danang with lots of photo stops such as Love Bridge, Dragon Bridge or visit Han Market, shopping center.

12:45-13:00 The bus and the tour guide pick you up at your hotel. Please be in the lobby at least 10 minutes before appointment time. Guests will visit the first attraction: Linh Ung Pagoda on Son Tra Peninsula, renowned for having the tallest statue of the Bodhisattva Avalokitesvara in Vietnam.

From here, they can admire the enchanted beauty of Da Nang City. Next, guests will begin their journey to the Marble Mountains. Accompanied by a tour guide, they will hear the legend behind the formation of the five Marble Mountains and climb 108 steps to visit Linh Ung Pagoda, the Relic Tower, and Tang Chon Cave... Stop at a local traditional store and freely go shopping... 16:00 The journey continues to Bay Mau Coconut Forest.

Enjoy a basket boat ride through the cool, green coconut palms, marvel at the rowers' skillful boat dances and spins, and take part in community entertainment on the water. The sweet Coconut Sweet Soup is a must-try local specialty here. The bus and the tour guide will take the guests to continue their journey to Hoi An Ancient Town, a Unesco World Cultural Heritage Site.

The guests will have dinner at a local restaurant near the ancient town, featuring a menu of Hoi An specialties crafted to suit local tastes. After dinner, the guests are free to explore Hoi An at night.

They can take a walk along the shimmering lantern-lit streets, admire the distinctly Asian architectural works, or participate in activities such as releasing flower lanterns and listening to Bai Choi folk songs (expenses not included).

20:30 Guests gather at the meeting point designated by the tour guide, then get on the bus.

The driver and tour guide will take the guests back to the hotel.

DAY 6 DANANG - BA NA HILLS - GOLDEN BRIDGE , FLY TO HO CHI MINH (B/L)

7:30-8:00 The bus and the tour guide pick you up at your hotel. Please be in the lobby at least 10 minutes before appointment time. Stop at a local traditional store and enjoy some free time for shopping while waiting for the tour guide to prepare the tour group list and tickets...

9:45-10:00 Guests arrive at the gate and board the single-cable car to enjoy the breathtaking view of the primeval forest (The world's longest single-wire cable car)

Next, visit the Lunar Castle, Dragon's Lair and Moonlight Square and watch movies at Mat Bay Theater, the most modern Moon Junction Theater in the world...

Guests enjoy a buffet lunch at the restaurant After lunch, free time to enjoy the mini shows, explore the fun-filled Fantasy Park, take photos at the French Village, or visit the Bana brew house

15:00 Take the short cable car ride and wander across the Golden Bridge - World's Leading Iconic Tourist Bridge, then immerse themselves in the beauty of hundreds of blooming flowers at Le Jardin Flower Garden....16:15-16:30 Guests take the cable car and go down to the Ba Na Hills gate, then get on the bus. The driver and tour guide will take the guests back to the hotel then transfer to the airport for the flight to Ho Chi Minh city.

Pick up at Tan Son Nhat Airport and transfer to hotel for check in.

DAY 7 HO CHI MINH - CU CHI FULL DAY (B/L)

Take the morning trip to visit Independence Palace, also known as the Reunification palace, was built on the sight of the former Norodom palace. The Independence palace is a widely known landmark of Ho Chi Minh City and was designed by the architect Ngo Viet Thu. Continue seeing the beautiful structures from the French Colonial times such as the Notre Dame Cathedral, the historic Central Post Office. Followed by the remarkable site of the War Remnants Museum the museum has a vast display of the both the Indochina wars. Have lunch at local restaurant.

Depart for Cu Chi tunnel, the trip will take approximately one and a half hours bus driving. Upon arrival, before exploring the tunnels, you will have some short introduction followed by introductory video about how the tunnels were constructed and how the people survived in the harsh conditions of the war time. Then, spend your time to explore the remaining area and tunnel systems which included the special constructed living areas with kitchens, bedrooms side by side with other martial facilities like storage, weapons factories, field hospitals, and command centers helping whoever lives inside the tunnels meet their basic needs. Besides, there are also many hidden trap doors and dangerous traps within the maze-like tunnels for security purpose during the war. Afterward, special tea and cassava (guerilla's food during the war) will be served.

Break time for relax or time for those who want to try the real shooting gun.

HOTEL : ALAGON SAIGON (4 Star) or similar

DAY 8 MEKONG DELTA DISCOVERY - DEPARTURE FLIGHT (B/L)

07:30 - 08:00 - Pick-up at hotels in District 1 or meeting point, depart for My Tho (1.5-hour drive). Visit Vinh Trang Pagoda, one of the most beautiful temples in the region.

Board a boat to explore the Mekong River, passing the four famous islands. Stop at Unicorn Island, taste tropical fruits & enjoy a folk music performance. Visit a honey bee farm, taste honey tea.

Explore a coconut candy workshop, see how sweets are made. 12:30 - Lunch at a local riverside restaurant. Optional: Short cycling trip around Tan Thach Village or relax in a hammock.

15:30 - Depart for Ho Chi Minh City. 17:30 - Arrival in Ho Chi Minh City
