## 5/9 Arrival in Nairobi (NBO) - Aberdare (L/D)

Arrive in Nairobi ; after being met at the airport, proceed to Aberdare National Park. Upon arrival at the lodge, enjoy a Chinese-style lunch. Afterward, you may choose to rest at the lodge—recharging your energy for the exciting journey ahead—or head to the Aberdare Country Club for a bush walk. This area is home to numerous herbivores—such as zebras, antelopes, and wildebeests—and offers the only opportunity within the national park to safely stroll on foot; with a bit of luck, you may even enjoy close-range interactions with these charming wild animals.

## 5/10 Aberdare - Lake Naivasha (B/L/D)

After breakfast at the hotel, you will check out and proceed to Lake Naivasha. Lake Naivasha- enveloped by grassy banks and acacia woodlands, Kenya's most beautiful freshwater lake sits atop the Rift valley at an astonishing 1884 meters above sea level The lake produces perch and African crucian carp, habitat to hippos and various waterfowl. You can take a speedboat cruise usually about 90 minutes during which you to get real close (as close as 5 meters) to these avian wonders- pigeons, flamingos, crows, and even fish eagles and you get to witness dozens of hippos wallowing in water and the different species of birds on Crescent Island. This island was one of the settings for the 19985 movie "Out of Africa" starring Meryl Streep.

## 5/11 Lake Naivasha - Masai Mara (B/L/D)

Start the day early with breakfast then head to Masai Mara, you will arrive just in time for lunch. After checking in and a short rest, get ready to be amazed as you take a trip through the world's most famous wildlife sanctuary, the Masai Mara National Park, This animal paradise spreads over about 1672 square kilometers of open plains, woodlands and riparian forests and was established in 1961. Masai Mara National Park is home to the world's largest wild mammal species, with about 95 species of mammals and 450 species of birds.

## 5/12 Masai Mara game reserve - Full day Safari (B/L/D)

Drive through the Masai Mara Prairie and go to the Mara River area to track and observe various wild animals in the Masai Mara National Park(Full Day). The Mara River in Africa flows through Kenya and Tanzania in Africa, with a total length of 395 kilometers and a drainage area of 13504 square kilometers, of which 60% are located in Kenya and 40% in Tanzania. The river originates in the rainy mountains of Kenya and the Great Migration constituting more than 1.5 million wildebeest trek in an enormous loop every year, with crossing the Mara River, migrating back and forth between Kenya's Masai Mara National Park and Tanzania's Serengeti National Park and this is recognized as one of the "Seven Wonders of the giant Nile crocodiles are the most difficult and spectacular scenes, which is why the crossing of the Mara River is often referred to as the crossing of the kingdom of heaven.

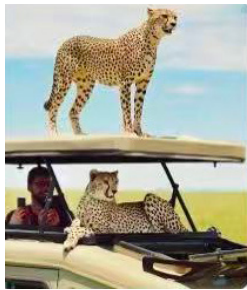
